Dr. Dietrich is a family physician and professor of community and family medicine at Dartmouth Medical School. He is a member of the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force and the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences. He is also associate director for population sciences at the Norris Cotton Cancer Center at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center and serves as chair of the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation Initiative on Depression and Primary Care. Dr. Dietrich is the president of NAPCRG - North American Primary Care Research Group.

Dr. Dietrich holds special interests in primary care research, especially quality improvement, preventive services, and mental health issues. Dr. Dietrich is currently working with the Department of Defense to improve the recognition and management of mental health issues of US troops post-deployment in Iraq.
