Stories from the field: A student's, and supervisor's, account of a participatory odyssey

In this interactive presentation, we will discuss the realities of a PhD student starting a new participatory research project in a community setting and the dynamics involved in the process of making her research goals compatible with the wishes and needs of the community. We will also reflect upon the dynamics of the student-supervisor relationship in terms of supporting a PhD student in a new participatory research project given the need to satisfy McGill's academic expectations and requirements for tenure. We will draw lessons learned from our experience and suggest key elements that may facilitate the student-supervisor relationship in the context of participatory research.
