

**Participatory analysis, visual methods and the democratic archive:
Giving life to data (to save lives) in the age of AIDS.**

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This presentation comes out of a recognition of the challenges and (opportunities) of engaging in participatory analysis in community based research in the context of HIV & AIDS. Drawing on work in rural KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa with community health care workers, the presentation addresses the *generative aspects of* using visual methodology tools such as community photography and participatory video, and the *potential* of new developments within the study of digital technologies to provide opportunities for researchers and communities to collaborate in working with the data.
